At the request of the Health Service Executive, RCSI have developed a specific Continuous Professional Development Support Scheme to facilitate NCHD's, who are not engaged in specialist training, to maintain their professional competence.

The scheme offers an array of classes in surgical skills, emergency medicine and human factors which carry PCS external credits recognised by the IMC.

The RCSI Continuous Professional Development Support Scheme will enable NCHD's enrolled in the programme to achieve a minimum of 20 external credits per annum. These credits can be counted towards meeting the NCHD's requirements as stipulated by the Medical Council regarding the maintenance of professional competence.

Eligible candidates can:

- › Receive feedback and advice from experts in the field
